# Road Policing Perth & Kinross:

## **April Outcomes**

April saw officers working alongside out partners in the DVSA carrying out road checks on the A90 at Parkford and Perthshire which recorded some good returns.

The Fatal Five Campaign resulted in multiple offences in relation to these crimes detected within the division.

Officers have had some notable drink/drug driving detections and recovered several stolen vehicles as well as carrying out intelligence led patrols targeting known offenders.

Taxi enforcement was carried out in Perth and this is to be continued going forward with action in all three LPA's.

Off Road motorbikes were targeted in Perth with two nights working with LPA staff and there was some notable seizures including one offender wanted on multiple warrants.

A foreign Drivers Initiative with LPA staff at A9 Bruar was well received by all, including local councillors in attendance. This will hopefully be replicated again more regularly.

The use of Body Worn Video Cameras is now live in D Division and all Officers have now been trained in its use. The past month has shown it to be invaluable evidence wise with very little teething issues locally in Road Policing.



## Knife Crime Awareness Week

Knife Crime Awareness Week is currently taking in Perth & Kinross from 19th to 25th May 2025. This annual event aims to raise awareness, educate and prevent knife crime.

Partners including Scottish Prison Service, Fearless, PKC, Aid & Abet, a representative from Scottish Government and Police Scotland will be working together to engage with our target audience on the topic.
